Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Are enrolments open?	Enrolments are open.
How do I enrol?	You need to contact your Year 6 transition coordinator and inform them that Cranbourne West Secondary College is your preferred school for 2021. We are only enrolling Year 7 students for 2021.

What will you teach?	A broad curriculum will be covered — English, Maths, Science, Humanities, Health and Physical Education, Indonesian, Visual and Performing Arts and Technology.
What is Supported Inclusion?	Supported Inclusion simply means that the school is built with a capacity to include more students with specialist learning needs than a regular mainstream school.
Is Cranbourne West a mainstream school?	Yes. It is the local mainstream secondary school for students who live within the zone.
What will happen in senior school?	The school will offer comprehensive programs in VCE, VCAL and VET. We will cater for all our students and provide appropriate pathways that meet their learning needs.

Is there sport?	Yes. We will have an outstanding sport program. The school will participate against other schools in inter-school competition, and we will have in-school swimming, athletics and cross-country programs.
What are the school colours?	Our school colours will be teal green, navy, white and silver.
What language will we study?	We will be studying Indonesian. Indonesia is a significant country for Australia in terms of geographic location, business opportunity, travel and tourism, and size.
How big will the classes be?	Class sizes will be between 22–25 depending on our total enrolments.
How are jobs advertised?	All positions will appear on Recruitment Online over the next few months.
What does the school day look like?	We will have five one-hour lessons per day. Home Group will run for 10 minutes.
