We are modernising and expanding Carlton Gardens Primary School, improving classrooms and creating places for an extra 150 local students.

The Victorian Government has invested \$10.59 million to deliver a smart, modern four-storey building with bridge links to the heritage and BER buildings.

## The school is gaining:

- flexible teaching and learning spaces
- an environmentally sustainable, state-of-the-art building
- accessible bridge links that connect the new heritage-approved four-storey building to existing ones
- a covered play area, external seating and landscaping

# Does the design address heritage concerns?

The project has received approval from Heritage Victoria and has been designed to be compatible with the existing heritage and BER buildings.

#### When will construction begin?

We plan to appoint a builder in Term 3 and begin construction in the final quarter of this year.

### When will works be complete?

Students and staff will be using the new building, the covered playground and all the other improvements at the start of the 2023 school year.
